United for Smart Sustainable Cities manages both a global set of KPIs and an Implementation Program

The U4SSC KPIs have been developed with the support of 16 UN agencies to become the first global standard for measuring and monitoring smart sustainable development at the local level

A U4SSC Implementation Program provides city level assessments and links cities to knowledge communities, solutions providers and funding opportunities




What to do

Listen, link and learn

Cities as playgrounds and platforms for open innovation where local leadership is trained and incentivised to *listen* in for and acknowledge interesting initiatives wherever they originate

Learning by doing and assuring that claims to knowledge are legitimate only in so far as positive impact is demonstrated




- 1. Gi alle kunnskap om status i sitt lokalsamfunn
